Given the adoption of Supreme Court Order 2007, the following presiding judges' orders are hereby vacated:

1. Third Presiding Judges' Statewide Covid-19 Pandemic Administrative Order, adopted May 29, 2020.
2. Presiding Judges' Statewide Administrative Order Governing Electronic Signatures of Judicial Officers, adopted December 10, 2020.
3. Presiding Judges' Second Amended Statewide Order on the Protocol for Photographing, Recording, or Streaming a Court Proceeding in Court Locations Where Social Distancing is Required, adopted May 19, 2022.

The following orders were superseded or vacated by subsequent order and are no longer in effect:

1. Presiding Judge Statewide Administrative Order Governing Relaxation and Suspension of Various Court Rules Based on the Covid-19 Pandemic, adopted March 23, 2020.<sup>1</sup>

8. Presiding Judges' Statewide District Court Eviction Protocol, adopted August 5, 2021.<sup>8</sup>
9. Presiding Judges' Amended Statewide Order on the Protocol for Photographing, Recording, or Streaming a Court Proceeding in Court Locations Where Social Distancing is Required, adopted April 11, 2022.
