ORDER NO. 1040

A mendments to Delinquency Rule 7(b) concerning emergency detention.

IT IS ORDERED:

1. Delinquency Rule 7(b) is amended to provide:

(b) Detention, Placement, Notification. If a juvenile is arrested, the juvenile must be taken immediately to a detention facility or placement facility designated by the Department or released pursuant to paragraph (c) of this rule. The arresting officer shall immediately notify the parents[,] or quardian [ AND DEPARTMENT] of the arrest and detention or placement and shall notify the court and Department immediately, if possible, and in no event more than 12 hours later. The arresting officer shall make and retain a written record of the notification. If the juvenile is arrested under subparagraph (a)(3) of this rule, prompt notification must also be given to the Department of Law.
