IT IS ORDERED:

- 1. Appellate Rule 407(a) is amended to provide:
 - (a) The supreme court may answer questions of law certified to it by the Supreme Court of the United States, a court of appeals of the United States, [OR] a States district court, a United States bankruptcy court or United States bankruptcy appellate panel, when requested by the certifying court if there involved in any proceeding before questions of law of this state which may be determinative of the cause then pending in the certifying court and as to which it appears to the certifying court there is no controlling precedent in the decisions of the supreme court of this state.
