### ORDER NO. 107

Amending Rule 17 (a), Rules of Administration and Rule 86 (i), Civil Rules

## IT IS ORDERED:

The Rules Governing the Administration of All Courts and the Rules of Civil Procedure are amended as set out below:

Rule 17 (a), <u>Rules Governing the Administration of</u> All <u>Courts</u>.

Is amended by deleting in line 2 of said subdivision the figure: "\$10.00" and substituting therefore the figure: "\$21.00."

Rule 86 (i), <u>Rules of Civil Procedure</u>. Is amended to read as follows:

(i) <u>Controverting Answer</u>. The plaintiff or the prisoner may, in a reply or at the hearing, controvert the answer under oath, to show either that the restraint of the prisoner was unlawful, or that he is entitled to his discharge or other appropriate remedy.
