## IT IS ORDERED:

- 1. Criminal Rule 25(d) is amended to provide:
  - (2) Procedure. [WITHIN FIVE DAYS AFTER A JUDGE IS ASSIGNED THE CASE FOR THE FIRST TIME, A] A party may exercise the party's right to a change of judge by filing a "Notice of Change of Judge" signed by counsel, if any, stating the name of the judge to be changed. The notice shall neither specify grounds nor be accompanied by an affidavit. The notice of change of judge is timely if filed within five days after notice that the case has been assigned to a specific judge.
