## ORDER NO. 1114

Amending Criminal Rule 31(e) concerning special verdict in theft cases.

## IT IS ORDERED:

- 1. Criminal Rule 31(e) is amended to provide:
  - (e) Special Verdicts--Insanity.
  - [(1) OFFENSES AGAINST PROPERTY. WHEN AN INDICTMENT CHARGES A THEFT OR THEFT-RELATED OFFENSE AGAINST PROPERTY, ON CONVICTION OF THE DEFENDANT THE JURY SHALL ASCERTAIN AND DECLARE IN THE VERDICT THE VALUE OF THE PROPERTY THAT WAS THE SUBJECT OF THE CRIME.
  - (2) INSANITY.] Where a defendant interposes the defense of insanity and evidence thereof is given at the trial, the jury, if it finds the defendant [HIM] not guilty on that ground, shall declare that fact in their verdict.
