Amending Administrative Rule 9 concerning vital statistics fees.

IT IS ORDERED:

1. Administrative Rule 9(e)(2) is amended to provide:

(e) Miscellaneous Fees in the Superior Court and the District Court:

(2) Certification.

A court can certify a copy of a document only if the original of the document is one file or recorded with the court. The cost of photocopying the document is included in the certification costs given below. For certifying a copy of any document excluding a vital statistics record (birth, death, marriage certificate) the cost is:

(i) Each document 5.00

(ii) For each additional certified copy of the document requested at the same time 2.00
