Amending Bar Rule 4 concerning examinations.

IT IS ORDERED:

Section 1 of Bar Rule 4 is amended to read as follows:

An applicant shall be allowed to take the bar examination once the applicant's application is approved by the board. Every applicant shall be notified no fewer than ten days in advance of the bar examination whether the application has been approved and shall be provided an examination permit—which shall state whether the examinee—is—an attorney applicant or a general applicant. The examination permit shall be presented to the examination proctor on the first day of the examination.
