Amending Administrative Rule 18 concerning business hours for superior and district courts.

IT IS ORDERED:

- 1. Administrative Rule 18(a) is amended to read:
 - Superior and District Courts When (a) Open for Business. The superior and district courts shall be open for the transaction of business during business hours from 8:00 a.m. until 4:30 p.m. on all days except judicial holidays and Saturdays; provided, however, that the courts may at any time extend these hours as circumstances may require or as may be ordered by the presiding judge. presiding judge may authorize the closure of an office for up to one hour per week for staff meetings and training under a plan approved by the administrative director. clerk of court must give advance notice of the closure by posting notices on the court's bulletin board. on the doors of the courthouse, and in the clerk's office.
