Amending Personnel Rules PX3.03 and C3.02.03 concerning the internal recruitment process.

IT IS ORDERED:

1. Personnel Rule PX3.03 is amended to read as follows:

PX3.03 <u>Promotional Selection Process</u> <u>Internal Recruitment</u> Process:

Exempt, partially exempt and temporary employees may not compete in selection recruitment processes in the classified service which are limited to regular, partially exempt, and probationary employees.

2. Personnel Rule C3.02.03 is amended to read as follows:

C3.02.03 Internal Recruitment Process

The personnel human resources director may announce a selection recruitment process on a promotional an internal basis when the personnel human resources director determines adequate competition exists among regular, partially exempt, and eligible probationary employees qualified for promotion. Notice of internal positions will be sent to all court locations and posted for at least five (5) working days after the date of the recruitment notice. A probationary employee must be continuously employed with the Alaska Court System for at least six (6) months to be

eligible to compete in any promotional selection internal recruitment process. When a promotional selection an internal recruitment process is announced, applications will be accepted from persons eligible for rehire and eligible probationary, partially exempt, and regular employees of the Alaska Court System only.
