## IN THE SUPREME COURT OF THE STATE OF ALASKA ORDER NO. 1448

Amending Criminal Rule 24(f) and Civil Rule 47(g) concerning jurors' oaths.

## IT IS ORDERED:

- I. Paragraph (f) of Criminal Rule 24 is amended to read as follows:
  - (f) Oath of Jurors. The jury shall be sworn by the clerk substantially as follows:

"You and each of you do solemnly swear (or affirm) that you will well and truly try the issues in the matter now before the court solely on the evidence introduced and in accordance with the instructions of the Court; so help you God."

- II. Paragraph (g) of Civil Rule 47 is amended to read as follows:
  - (g) Oath of Jurors. The jury shall be sworn by the clerk substantially as follows:

"You and each of you do solemnly swear (or affirm) that you will well and truly try the issues in the matter now before the court solely on the evidence introduced and in accordance with the instructions of the court; so help you God."
