Amending Appellate Rule 215(g) concerning page limits for Memoranda on Appeal.

IT IS ORDERED:

Appellate Rule 215(g) is amended to read as follows:

(g) Memoranda on Appeal.

(4) Form and Contents of Memoranda. The memoranda filed by either the appellant or the appellee need not comply with the requirements of Appellate Rule 212 unless ordered by the appellate court.

(5) Length. Exclusive of appendices, the appellant's and appellee's memoranda may not exceed 25 numbered pages each. A motion for leave to file a memorandum longer than permitted by this paragraph must be accompanied by a copy of the over-length memorandum proposed to be filed.

(5)(6) Service of Memoranda. When filed, the original memoranda shall be accompanied by proof of service on opposing counsel.
