(d) Mailing of Papers for Filing. Papers may be filed either by delivering them to the office of the clerk of the appellate courts in Anchorage, Fairbanks, or Juneau, or by mailing them to: Clerk of the Appellate Courts, 303 K Street, Anchorage, Alaska 99501. The date of mailing, as shown by the postmark or other proof from the post office, will be deemed to be the date of filing. A postmark date from a privately owned postage meter will not suffice as proof of the date of mailing and papers postmarked in this manner will be deemed filed on the date of receipt by the clerk.
