IT IS ORDERED:

Criminal Rule 12 is amended to read as follows:

Rule 12. Pleadings and Motions Before Trial — Defenses and Objections.

* * * *

(c) **Pretrial Motion Date.** In misdemeanor cases, <u>Aall</u> pretrial motions listed in Rule 12(b) must be filed within <u>4520</u> days after the defendant's arraignment. In felony cases, all pretrial motions listed in Rule 12(b) must be filed within <u>45</u> days after the defendant's arraignment. The court may vary these times for good cause shown.
