## IN THE SUPREME COURT OF THE STATE OF ALASKA ORDER NO. 1649

Amending Administrative Rule 12(e)(5) concerning compensation for attorneys appointed at public expense.

## **IT IS ORDERED:**

Administrative Rule 12 is amended to read as follows:

Rule 12. Procedure for Counsel and Guardian ad Litem Appointments at Public Expense.

- (e) Other Appointments at Public Expense.
  - (1) Constitutionally Required Appointments.

(5) *Compensation.* (A) All claims for compensation must be submitted on forms provided by the court within 30 days following the disposition of a case. Claims will be submitted to the assigned trial judge or master, who shall make a

recommendation regarding approval and forward the recommendation to the administrative director. The administrative director shall approve or disapprove the claim.

(B) Attorneys will be compensated at the rate of \$75.00 per hour; provided, that total compensation for any case will not exceed \$1,000.00 without prior approval of the administrative director.
