IT IS ORDERED:

Civil Rule 4(h) shall be amended to read as follows: 4(h) Service of Summons by Mail. In addition to other methods of Service provided by this rule, Summons may also be served within the state by registered or certified mail upon an individual other than an infant or an incompetent person and upon a corporation, partnership, and unincorporated association. In such case, copies of the summons and complaint shall be mailed by the clerk for delivery only to the party to whom the summons is directed. All returned delivery receipts shall be so addressed that they are returned to the party requesting the summons or his attorney. Proof of service shall be made to the court by affidavit.
