IT IS ORDERED:

Rule 24(c), Rules Governing the Administration of All Courts, is amended to read as follows:

(c) Appointment pro tempore. The Chief Justice may by special assignment appoint a retired justice or a retired judge of the Superior Court to sit pro tempore in any court of this state, and a retired judge of the District Court to sit as judge of the District Court pro tempore where such assignment is deemed necessary for the efficient administration of justice.
