## IN THE SUPREME COURT OF THE STATE OF ALASKA ORDER NO. 1935

Amending Criminal Rule 41(b) to expand the types of bonds, as permitted by statute.

## IT IS ORDERED:

Criminal Rule 41(b) is amended to read as follows:

Rule 41. Bail.

\* \* \*

- (b) **Types of Bonds.** The court may require:
- (1) the execution of an unsecured appearance bond or an unsecured performance bond in an amount specified, under the criteria set forth in AS 12.30.011;
- (2) the execution of an appearance bond in a specified amount and the deposit in the registry of the court, in cash, of a sum not to exceed 10 percent of the amount of the bond;
- (3) the execution of a bail bond with sufficient solvent sureties or the deposit of cash; or
- (4) the execution of a performance bond in a specified amount and the deposit in the registry of the court of cash.
