THE SUPREME COURT OF THE STATE OF ALASKA ORDER NO. 274

Amending Rule 6(a), Rules of Civil Procedure, relatin to computation of periods of time.

IT IS ORDERED:

Rule 6(a), Rules of Civil Procedure, is amended to read:

(a) <u>Computation</u>. In computing any period of time prescribed or allowed by these rules, by order of court, or by any applicable statute, the day of the act, event, or default from which the designated period of time begins to run is not to be included. The last day of the period is to be included, unless it is a Saturday, a Sunday, or a legal holiday, in which event the period runs until the end of the next day which is not a Saturday, Sunday, or legal holiday. When the period of time prescribed or allowed is less than seven days, intermediate Saturdays, Sundays, and legal holidays shall be excluded in the computation. A half holiday shall be considered as other days and not as a holiday.
