## ORDER NO. 287

Repealing and re-promulgating Appellate Rule 26, providing for summary disposition of appeals.

IT IS ORDERED:

Appellate Rule 26 is repealed and re-promulgated to read:

Rule 26. <u>Summary Disposition of Appeals</u>. (a) The court may determine that an appeal shall be disposed of by summary order and without formal written opinion. To assist the court in making this determination, the parties may request in writing that an appeal be so decided. The request shall be signed by all parties and may be filed any time after the filing of the notice of appeal.

(b) Nothing in this rule limits the right of the parties to oral argument pursuant to Appellate Rule 18. (c) Appeals decided summarily under this rule are without precedential effect and may not be cited in the courts of this state.
