IT IS ORDERED:

Rule 7, District Court Rules of Civil Procedure, is amended to read:

<u>Appointment and Authority of Clerk</u>. In court locations where there is no superior court judge regularly sitting, a district judge may by order appoint a clerk authorized to issue process and to sign and enter the orders and judgments set forth in Civil Rule 73(b) and (c). In the absence of an order appointing a clerk, process shall be issued and orders and judgments signed by the district judge or by a magistrate.
