ORDER NO. 325

Rescinding Supreme Court
Order No. 59 and
Re-promulgating the Fee
Schedule as Rule 11, Rules
Governing the Administra-
tion of All Courts.

IT IS ORDERED:

1. Supreme Court Order No. 59, as amended, is rescinded.
2. Rule 11, Rules Governing the Administration of All Courts, is rescinded and re-promulgated to read:

Rule 11., SCHEDULE OF FEES.

The fees specified in this rule shall be charged for the services designated herein:

I. IN THE SUPREME COURT:

(a) Filing Fees:

1. Upon filing a written notice of appeal or cross-appeal (Appellate Rule 7(b) and Appellate Rule 19) \$50.00
2. Upon filing a petition for review or cross-petition for review (Appellate Rule 24(b)) 50.00
3. Upon filing original proceedings (Appellate Rule 25). 50.00

(b) Miscellaneous Fees:

1. For preparation of case record for review by the Supreme Court of the United States 50.00
2. For copies of records on file with the Supreme Court, whether or not certified:
First page or fraction thereof 1.25
Each additional page or any fraction thereof25
3. For copies of court opinions, per opinion 1.00
4. For annual subscription to court opinions 50.00

II. FILING FEES -- SUPERIOR COURT:

(a)	Upon filing any civil case, including a petition for deposition before action	\$50.00
(b)	For probate masters:	
1.	Initial filing fee	50.00
2.	For depositing a will with the court for safe keeping	10.00
3.	For registration of a trust document	10.00
4.	Upon filing a petition for court approval of a minor's settlement, when it involves opening a new file	30.00
(c)	Upon filing of an adoption proceeding, without regard to the number of minors involved	30.00
(d)	Upon filing any guardianship, conservatorship or other protective proceedings to include all services in the first year	30.00
(e)	Upon filing annual guardianship reports in each succeeding year	10.00
(f)	Upon filing an appeal or petition for review from district court, except in forma pauperis cases	15.00
(g)	Upon filing an action to enjoin or enforce orders of the Alaska Workmen's Compensation Board	50.00
(h)	Upon filing an action for review of a decision by the Department of Labor under AS 23.20 (Employment Security Act), except as exempted by AS 23.20.460	50.00
(i)	Upon filing an appeal or petition for review from an administrative order (AS 44.62.560)	50.00
(j)	In cases arising under the Uniform Reciprocal Enforcement of Support Act, all ordinary fees shall be charged, subject to the waiver provisions of Supreme Court Order No. 19.	

III. FILING FEES -- DISTRICT COURT:

(a)	Filing fees, District Court jurisdiction	25.00
(b)	Filing fees, Small Claims actions	5.00
(c)	Filing fees where Magistrates accept for filing civil cases beyond their jurisdiction, but within the jurisdiction of the District Court (Rule 40(a) Administrative Rules)	25.00

IV. TRANSCRIPT AND RELATED FEES:

- (a) For preparation of any transcript of proceedings, whether or not an appeal is taken:
 - 1. Original, per page or fraction thereof \$ 2.00
 - 2. Each additional copy, per page or fraction thereof75
- (b) For any transcript during trial or otherwise for which immediate priority in preparation is requested:
 - 1. Original, per page or fraction thereof 3.00
 - 2. Each additional copy, per page or fraction thereof 1.00
- (c) For recording depositions with court recording equipment, per each 1/2 hour, or fraction thereof 5.00
- (d) Cassette transcripts, each 90 minute tape 5.00

V. MISCELLANEOUS FEES:

- (a) For certifying or conforming a copy of any document of record, where copy is furnished 1.00
- (b) For copying any document, (except vital statistics records) by photocopy process or other means, whether or not certifying is required:
 - 1. First page or fraction thereof 1.25
 - 2. Each additional page or fraction thereof25

(When more than one copy of a document is requested, the "first page" fee applies only to the first copy; the "each additional page" fee applies to all pages of the additional copies. A "page" means one side of a sheet.)
- (c) For photocopying or otherwise preparing and certifying a copy of a vital statistics record (birth, death, marriage certificates):
 - 1. Each document 3.00
 - 2. For each additional copy of the document requested at the same time 1.00
- (d) For issuing a certificate of office to a notary public 5.00
- (e) For issuing exemplifications 5.00

(f) For filing or recording certificates of license to practice in learned professions \$ 5.00

(g) For notary public services:

1. For certifying and taking an affidavit and affixing the court seal 2.50

2. For taking acknowledgment of any instrument in writing 3.00

(This fee shall not apply to acknowledgments of documents that are to be filed in a pending action.)

(h) For filing articles of incorporation as required by law 10.00

(i) For filing oaths of office as required by law 2.00

(j) For providing in writing requested information from search of records, per page or fraction thereof 2.00

(k) For service of process:

1. By certified mail 2.00

2. By registered mail 3.00

(Except in small claims actions, necessary postage, an addressed envelope for mailing and completed postal forms for the delivery receipt and the record of mailing must be supplied by the party requesting service by mail.)

(l) For issuing and filing marriage license 3.00

(m) For filing marriage certificate 3.00

(When a marriage license is issued by a court office, the fee for filing the marriage certificate should be collected at that time.)

(n) For performing marriage ceremony 10.00

VI. GENERAL PROVISIONS:

(a) No filing, certifying, or copying fee shall be charged to any agency of the State of Alaska.


(b) Except in small claims actions, postage may be charged in all courts where airmail or special mailing services are requested.

- (c) Notarization required in an action by a person represented in such action by an attorney furnished to him by an organization authorized to provide legal services to indigents are exempted from notary public fees provided under this schedule.
- (d) Before accepting any civil action or proceeding for filing, a filing fee in the amount prescribed in this rule shall be collected. Further or additional fees or charges shall be made by the clerk or magistrate with respect to such action or proceeding only for additional services as specified in this rule.


