Amending Subsection (4) of Paragraph (c), Rule 39, Alaska Rules of Criminal Procedure, Relating to the Payment of Appointed Counsel in Criminal Cases.

IT IS ORDERED:

Subsection (4) of Paragraph (c), Rule 39, Alaska Rules of Criminal Procedure, is amended to read:

- (4) The cost of services of counsel shall be calculated at the hourly rate provided in Administrative Rule 12 (f). At the hearing, counsel for the defendant shall provide evidence of:
 - (i) the hours he or she has expended to date;
- (ii) an estimate of the hours, if any, still required to be expended on behalf of the defendant; and
- (111) any costs and expenses that are expected to be incurred or that have actually been incurred by private counsel or by the Public Defender Agency, including a reasonable estimate of the cost to the Public Defender Agency of any services provided on behalf of the defendant by investigators appointed by the Public Defender Agency. Reimbursement for costs and expenses incurred by private counsel shall not exceed \$250.00 unless authorization is obtained in advance in accordance with paragraphs (g) and (h) of Administrative Rule 12.
