Correcting an Error in
Administrative Rule 28(a)


IT IS ORDERED:

Paragraph (a) of Rule 28, Rules Governing the Administration of All Courts is amended to read as follows:


(a) Vacation Leave. Each supreme court justice, court of appeals judge and superior court judge shall be entitled to an annual vacation of not more than 30 working days. It shall be taken at such time or times as may be prescribed by the chief justice of the supreme court, the chief judge of the court of appeals, or the presiding judge of the appropriate judicial district. Vacation time not taken in any calendar year may be accumulated. However, no more than 15 working days' vacation time may be accumulated in any one year, and no judge may carry over more than 30 working days' unused vacation time in the aggregate. In addition, each supreme court justice, court of appeals judge, and superior court judge shall be entitled to sick leave with respect to any period of illness necessitating absence from his or her judicial duties, which sick leave shall not be charged against his or her vacation time. Annual vacation leave accrues as of January 1 of each year except for the year during which a justice or judge is appointed or retires. During the year of appointment, resignation, or retirement, annual vacation leave accrues at the rate of 2.5 days per month of service. Annual vacation time accrued but not taken at the time of resignation or retirement is forfeited.




