ORDER NO. 463

Amending Rule 6, Alaska Bar Rules, Relating to Appeals from Denials of Bar Exam Permits on the Basis of Character.

IT IS ORDERED:

Rule 6, Rules of the Alaska Bar Association, is amended by adding new Section 8 to read:

<u>Section 8</u>. When the Board denies an examination permit on the basis of character, the Board shall give the applicant immediate written notice of its action, together with a statement of the specific grounds on which the denial of the examination permit is based. Within 10 days of receipt of such written notice, the applicant may submit to the Board such written argument, documentation, or other material as the applicant deems relevant to the proof of his or her good moral character. Upon receipt of any such material, the Board shall reconsider the denial in a timely fashion and give written notice of its decision.
