ORDER NO. 492

Amending Appellate Rules 403 and 404, relating to Petitions for Review and Original Applications.

## IT IS ORDERED:

1. Appellate Rule 403(a) is amended by adding at the end thereof a new paragraph (4) to read as follows:

(4) Notice to Trial Court. Upon the filing of a petition for review, the Clerk of the Appellate Courts shall promptly notify the judge whose order is sought to be reviewed, and the clerk of his court, informing them of the date and identity of the order sought to be reviewed, the name of the party filing the petition, and the docket number assigned to the petition in the appellate court. The Clerk of the Appellate Courts shall also promptly notify them of the action taken by the appellate court on the petition. Order No. <u>492</u> Page 2 of 2 Effective Date: <u>January 4, 1982</u>

2. Appellate Rule 404(b) is amended by adding at the end thereof a new paragraph (4) to read as follows: (4) If the original application pertains to a proceeding in a trial court, the Clerk of the Appellate Courts shall comply with Rule 403(a)(4).
