
Temporarily Suspending the
Provisions of Rule 32,
Rules Governing the
Administration of All
Courts, for the Courts in
Anchorage and Fairbanks.

IT IS ORDERED:

The provisions of Rule 32, Rules Governing the Administration of All Courts, are suspended for the courts in Anchorage and Fairbanks until October 21, 1983, to allow magistrates to hear, try and enter judgments in all cases involving traffic infractions under Title 28, Alaska Statutes, and violations of ordinances of political subdivisions where the maximum penalty that may be imposed is a fine.


