## THE SUPREME COURT OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

ORDER NO. 597

Amending Administrative Rule 23, Relating to Personal Leave for Pro Tem Judges

## IT IS ORDERED:

Administrative Rule 23 is amended by adding to paragraph

- (b) the following language in order that the entire paragraph reads:
  - (b) Compensation. The retired justice or judge is entitled to receive compensation for judicial service pro tempore in an amount equal to the salary of a justice or a judge of the court to which he was assigned pro tempore for the period of such service diminished by the amount of retirement pay if any is received by him for such period. The retired justice or judge is further entitled to receive full medical insurance coverage during the same period. The retired justice or judge is not entitled to personal, annual, or sick leave benefits, and acceptance of an appointment pro tempore acts as a waiver of any claim to such benefits. For an appointment of over ninety consecutive days, such leave may be granted at the discretion of the administrative director upon confirmation by the chief justice.
