## THE SUPREME COURT OF THE STATE OF ALASKA ORDER NO. 643

Technical Amendment Relating to Criminal Rule 32.1(a)

## IT IS ORDERED:

Criminal Rule 32.1(a) is amended to read as follows:

A person convicted of a crime after trial shall be advised by the judge or magistrate:

That he has the right to appeal from the judgment of conviction within 30 days (or 15 days in appeals from the district court made under Rule 217, Alaska Rules of Appellate Procedure) from the date shown in the clerk's certificate of distribution on the judgment appealed from by filing a notice of appeal with the Clerk of Court.
