ORDER NO. 921

Amending Civil Rule 82(a)(2) concerning attorney fees in default cases.

IT IS ORDERED:

Civil Rule 82(a)(2) is amended to provide:

(2) In actions where the money judgment is not an accurate criteria for determining the fee to be allowed to the prevailing side, the court shall award a fee commensurate with the amount and value of legal services rendered. An application for attorney's fees in a default case exceeding \$50,000 must specify actual fees.
